

3 Highlanders Recognized as All-BCC

(BERKELEY HEIGHTS) – 3 members of this year's Governor Livingston Football Team have been recognized as All- Big Central Conference players. The Big Central Conference is composed of 59 schools, representing the counties of Union, Middlesex, Somerset, Hunterdon, and Warren.

David Dorsett, OT, Sr. – 2nd Team All-BCC

This is Dorsett's first career All-BCC selection. Dorsett was a team captain and a three-year starter at offensive tackle, defensive end, and long snapper. Offensively, Dorsett teamed with guard Max DiDonato to form an impenetrable left side of the offensive line.

Defensively, facing regular double teams, Dorsett still registered 50 total tackles, 1 sack, 4 pass breakups, and a team-leading 16.5 tackles for loss.

Max DiDonato, ILB, Sr. – 3rd Team All-BCC

This is DiDonato's first career All-BCC selection. DiDonato was a team captain and a four-year varsity starter at left guard. In addition to his stellar offensive line play, DiDonato took over the Mike linebacker spot, after spot duty defensively last season. DiDonato turned in a strong performance with a team-leading 94 total tackles. He also had 8.5 tackles for loss, 1 sack, and 1 fumble recovery.

Joey Switlyk, C, Jr. – Honorable Mention All-BCC

This is Switlyk's first career All-BCC selection. Switlyk stepped in as the starting center after Week 3 of his sophomore season. He is now the anchor of an offensive line that averaged 175.2 rushing yards per game while routinely taking on larger defensive linemen.
